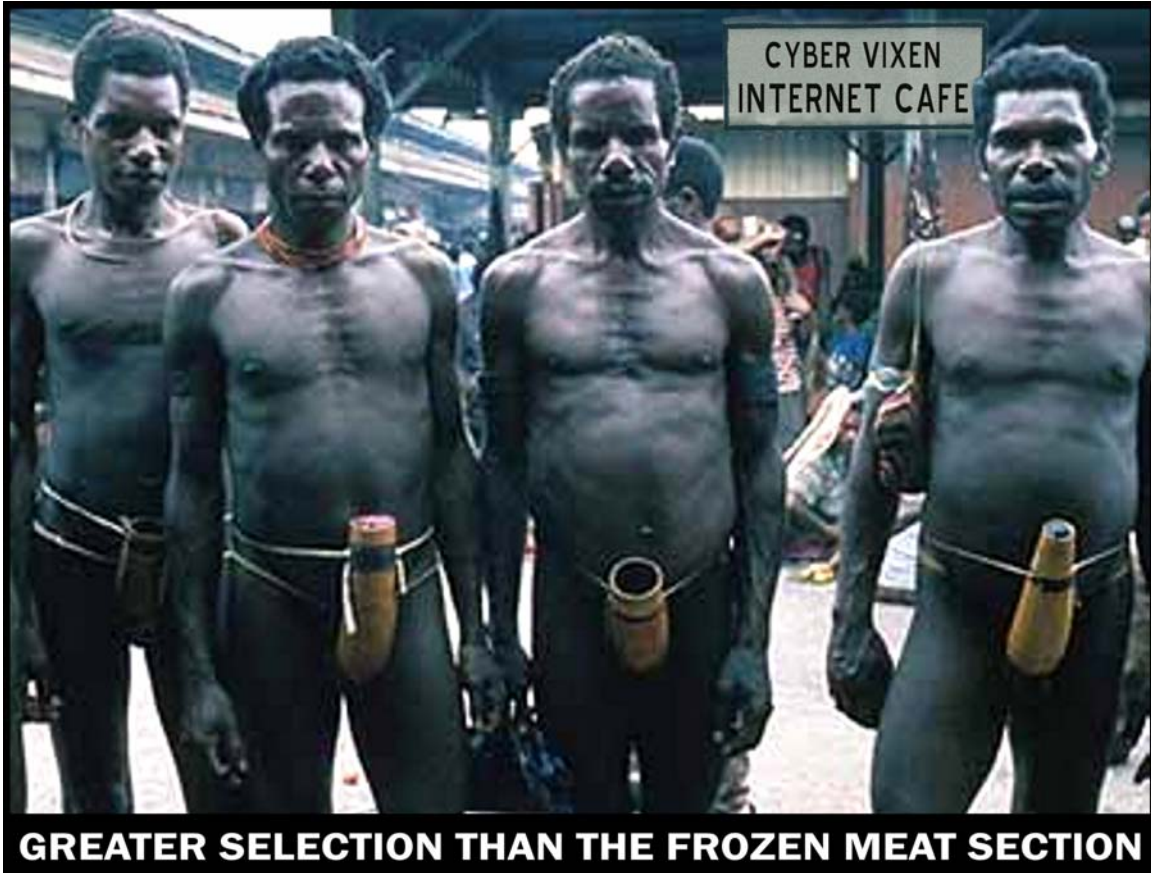
Always be honest about who and what you are

Chapter 2

Choosing the right service to use for online dating is as important as choosing the right diaphragm: if it's not right for you, it can be uncomfortable, time consuming, and expensive down the road.

In this chapter we will deal primarily with *legitimate* dating services for the average hetero, "female looking for male" scenario. In chapter eleven, "Binary Curious" we will cover services for those Cyber Vixens with more *eclectic* tastes and desires (purr – slap - giggle).

These are *not* your Mother's dating services

When most people think of dating services they think of those video dating services where a "plain Jane" or a "geeky guy" nervously talk about themselves into a camera. Not only are these traditional dating services uncomfortable, but they are quite expensive. As a "Cyber Vixen," with the click of the mouse you can easily be *your own matchmaker* – and you don't even have to be Jewish! They once said that a good man is hard to find, *or was it a hard man is good to find?* Now, thanks to the power of the internet, you have literally thousands of prospects to choose from – and some of them even have teeth and jobs.

You get what you pay for

It all boils down to your budget and what you're looking for. Sure, there are plenty of *free* services, but we don't suggest being penny wise and dating foolish. Why pay for it? We have learned that the highest success rate for "hyperlink hunk hookups" comes from using services that charge a small fee. This small fee usually increases your selection and tends to weed out a lot of the riff-raff (with fewer trips to the store for Monistat 7).

If you're seeking a lasting relationship (and in this chapter we assume you are), we have assembled a list of dating sites to choose from. These subscription sites generally charge less than \$25.00 a month. Most of them offer a free trial period (so you can separate the perverts from the perfect, the freaks from the Fabios, the asses from the Adonis – you get the idea).

Go down the list and check out the sites! There are many to choose from and we listed our favorites first. We made our choices based on ease of use, size of selection, recommendations, and highest success ratings.

Our Top "pay sites" choices are:

www.Match.com Match.com – This is one of the most successful and our favorite. They boast a pool of over eight million subscribers (and some of them

are even attractive)! Greater selection means greater satisfaction. If women on death row can find men for conjugal visits – why not you?

www.LoveAtAol.com Love at AOL – Same search engine as match.com, but more “AOL friendly” for those of you who are too shy or afraid to click outside your AOL world (AOL: keyword LOVE).

www.matchmaker.com Matchmaker – The reason this site didn’t make number one (besides having fewer subscribers than Match.com) is because; while we were using it, we noticed that we could see where other people are on the site and what they’re doing at that particular moment...and we prefer our anonymity. However, one of our closest friends met a male stripper here, so maybe you could hook up with your own “Chip” or “Dale.” On a positive note: Daniel’s brother and his wife both met on Matchmaker...and they’re now expecting a baby!

www.YahooPersonals.com Yahoo Personals – Not quite as user-friendly, and seems to have a lot of foreign applicants. Although we don’t particularly like “chat” sites in the online dating world, “Yahoo chat” is an interesting added feature. The worst part of chatting online is; you don’t always know who you are chatting to. The best part of chatting online is; it’s one of the few times men will actually listen.

www.dating.com Dating.com – Visually, a very nice clone of Match.com...except for the fact that that the pictures are too small (no matter what the doctors say, size does matter). Also, they seem to have a limited selection of applicants. But if you’re a fan of web design and own a magnifying glass, this site will work fine.

www.jdate.com JDate – Primarily for Jewish daters...but fear not, they also have a “Boy meets Goy” section. This is a great site if you have a yarmulke fetish or prefer your men circumcised.

www.lavalife.com Lavalife – Well designed, easy to use, and has regular dating combined with options for good old-fashioned “cyber sleepin’ around” action.

www.FriendFinder.com Friend Finder – As its name would imply, is a site for women seeking sensitive, caring, males, looking for friends and companions. The very same people host ChurchFriendFinder.com where you can meet people of your own faith. Ironically, they also host adultfriendfinder.com, where you can find a significant hump-buddy for your own private “*Religious experience.*”

www.friendster.com Friendster – an online community that connects people through networks of friends for dating or making *new* friends. It follows the “Six Degrees” approach to meeting people. This is an unusual and surprisingly fun site – especially if you’re young, hip and prefer dating people that are “Six Degrees from Kevin Bacon.”

www.2ofaKindOnline.com 2 of a Kind – "61% of singles will look for a date on the internet this year. Most will go to sites like 2ofakind.com" – NY Times. This is a better review than 61% of new musicals will get in the New York Times.

www.advanceddegreessingles.com Advanced Degree Singles – A meat market for mega-brains with a master's degree (or higher). This is a site for highly educated professionals who prefer to only date *other* highly educated professionals (and Mensa candidates). Sure, these men pass the written test but I wonder how they do on the *oral*?

www.americansingles.com American Singles – If you love Baseball, apple pie, drive a Chevrolet and only "buy American." here's a chance to combine your dating *and* patriotism.

www.matchamerica.com Match America – More of the same, bla bla bla, yada yada yada.

www.eharmony.com E Harmony – This site is growing very rapidly, due to a successful television ad campaign. Their entrance questionnaires are so detailed, you'll wonder if you're applying for a government job. We suggest this site for the anal-retentive, or if you want to be politically correct *detail-oriented* who want to know more about a man than he knows about himself.

www.heart2heart.com Heart 2 Heart – This site is very pretty. Some would say *too pretty*. This site as an endless calliope of pinks and reds, hearts and flowers. We thought it resembled a children's Holly Hobby notebook. Like an over sized dildo; this site is visually shocking, but effective.

www.astromate.com Astro Mate – Even though men are dogs, "Astro" in this case does not refer to the dog in "The Jetsons." This is the only service that uses astrology to find your match made in the heavens. We caution you; men who plan their lives by the stars are rarely down to earth.

www.militarysingles.com Military Singles – The dating site for single soldiers (male and female). We suggest this site for women seeking military men, who don't mind dating "an army of one."

www.bbwwdatefinder.com BBW Date Finder – A meeting place for big beautiful women and their admirers. Cris insisted that we include this site because he's a fan of the full figured gals. If you got a little "junk in the trunk," here's where you'll find a collector.

www.ruralsingles.com Rural Singles – A rustic web site for cowgirls – or any woman who has seen the movie "Urban Cowboy," more than eight times.

www.unionworkerssingles.com Union Worker Singles – If you're a SWF seeking a SWM for LTR in the AFLCIO, this site is for you.

www.latinmatcher.com Latin Matchmaking – This zesty site is for women who want passionate relationships with Latino males. We suggest this a site for women who like dancing and want to try the horizontal Lambada).

www.hiphopmatchmaker.com Hip-hop Matchmaker – Yo, yo! Listen up, boo. Check dis site an' get the 411 on all da players. "Cyber Vixen" in da house!

www.countrymatch.com Country Match – This is a site for "Cyber Vixens" who think that there is nothing sexier than a man with Camel toe and a mullet. We hope you think 14 seconds is a long ride – Yee haw!

www.SeniorFriendFinder.com Senior Friend Finder – We know Cyber Vixens come in all ages. At Senior Friend Finder, you'll find a community of singles, over 50 years old and *above*. You'll find tools to make connections, find romance, dates, friends and pen pals. Of course over the age of 50, there is no guarantee they will ever remember you.

(Creating the Perfect Profile for finding your Mr. Right)



Chapter 3

The *most* important part of online dating; setting up your profile

Your success as a Cyber Vixen depends upon this often painful task. Like a job resume, your personal profile represents you and enables you to *fill the position*. And trust us – there are many positions to fill (see Karma Sutra). Unlike a job resume, where you have a full page to sell yourself, you will generally have one paragraph to describe yourself and a separate paragraph to describe what you seek. The good news is; as a Cyber Vixen, the cyber males are *seeking you* and you are the one doing a majority of the hiring and firing. *You go, girl!*

Let's face facts, if Macys wants to sell something, they display it *in the best way they can* in the front window

Be positive, be honest, be brief, and don't be needy or negative.

A successful Cyber Vixen is upbeat and honest about herself and about what she is looking for

Take some time out from your busy schedule, get a piece of paper and a pencil, and write a list of “positives” about yourself. Make a list five to seven items long, containing brief one-word adjectives about you. Then form a nice cheerful paragraph describing yourself (using your favorite *three* from the list). Write in simple, coherent sentences (remember men are simple creatures) and try not to make your paragraph any longer than the average paragraph in this book - specifically this one.

What are you seeking?

This seems like a simple question. Unfortunately, the “seeking” paragraph is where many women (and men) destroy their chances for successful dating on the “web of plenty.” Take your time and really think about it. Write it down, think some more...and then write it down *again*. A little goal-oriented, self evaluation goes a long way here. Don't waste your time looking for something, without knowing what you're looking for. Men are frustrated by women who don't know what they want – almost as much as women are frustrated by men who have trouble with *responsibility* and *commitment*.

Be an honest, upbeat and *specific* Cyber Vixen in your “seeking” paragraph

Don't be a victim of the common mistake of uncertainty, that's often made by both men and women. The end result will make you happier and successful.

Before you get too nervous about this paramount undertaking...remember; you can always go back and change your bio/profile

We strongly suggest that you change and update your information *at least* once a week. Why change so often? The more you work on your profile, the better it will get. Also, updated profiles tend to show up at the top of the search results (tricky, tricky).

See what the other Cyber Vixens are up to!

In this chapter we've put some examples of basic web profiles. We also suggest that you check out your competition. A simple way to do this is to enter "Male" seeking "Female" into the search engine. This way, you can see how others have presented (or misrepresented) themselves. Learn from our mistakes and other Cyber Vixens.

We Repeat be positive, be honest, be brief and don't come off as needy or negative

Make several drafts of your two brief paragraphs and then go through our general rules section in this chapter. See where you *followed* the rules and where you've *broken* them. Then correct your mistakes. You might even call a girlfriend who also is an internet dater, and read it to them. Avoid getting advice from negative people or bag ladies who shout at traffic.

Your prime objective is to start a constructive dialogue with your prospective "Mac Daddy" that will lead to the relationship *you* are looking for

General rules for writing a Vixen Profile/Bio are:

- Pick a good username that is cute or clever – not something boring like Jane123 (Zzzzzzzzzzz - boring). Use a good name that they will write to and even inspire correspondence like "SunsetSue" or RollerGirl. Examples of Names to avoid are "BiPolarPatty," "RehabRhonda," "CamelToeKara," "LargeMarge," and "BettysBaggage."
- Have an eye catching and/or interesting headline for your profile. Headlines to avoid are "Pull my finger," "All you can eat!" and "Emotional Succubus".

- Keep it short and simple don't go on, and on about yourself. Leave something to talk about at your meeting.
- Try to avoid boring clichés. Stupid is a stupid does.
- Be honest about yourself – but not brutally honest.
- Be confident, not conceited.
- Be interesting, different, creative and funny...even if you are not.
- Be friendly.
- Be positive about yourself and others. Don't use this as a forum to air your complaints about the opposite sex and your own insecurities.
- Try to make your seeking and your bio *roughly* the same length.
- Know your competition. Check out other Cyber Vixens to see what they have done well...and what to avoid.
- Read over your profile for errors and use spell check.
- Try to avoid sounding like a gold digger – even Sugar Daddies are paranoid about that.
- Make your profile fun to read
- Update your information often using our guidelines – wash, rinse, and repeat –wash, rinse, and repeat.

Information to you might consider putting in your profile:

- What makes you tick (not your biological clock)?
- What are your hobbies, pottery, reading etc. (legal hobbies)?
- What is your ideal night out (especially avoid clichés on this one)?
- What is your profession (very optional)?
- How do you spend your spare time (if you have spare time)?
- Favorite Authors, Films, Plays, Music (preferably not “chick flicks”)?

- Do you have children (that you're aware of)?
- If you could travel any where, where would you go and why?
- Where are you from – roughly (more specific than “planet earth”)?
- Do you have any pets (*don't list pet peeves*)?
- Do you dance? (on a date – not stripping)?
- What are you looking for (we repeat try to be specific)?
- Show off your positive qualities (keep looking, you'll find them).
- What do you want in a relationship (not sexually, *save that for later*)?

Well, how did you do?

Did our tips work for you? Did you represent yourself in a positive light? Did you state clearly and positively what you looking for? If so, great! If not, go back read over our suggestions once more – and try again (sigh).

A handy tip from those “in the know”


Many Cyber Vixens receive massive quantities of email after setting up and posting their profiles. You might want to consider setting up a *separate* email account *just for online dating* correspondence. This is the address to put in the “email” field of your “account settings.” If you're an AOL user, you can have up to seven screen names (for no additional fee). If you prefer, you can sign up for a free email account at www.hotmail.com, www.yahoo.com or one of the other many free email services. At Cyber Vixen, we think there's nothing more exciting than deleting spam and rejecting Cyber Losers in bulk.

Brains are very sexy! I'd prefer a man who enjoys his work, takes care of himself and smells good. I'm looking for someone who sees the opportunity not the impossibility. Good communication is vital. I love a man who can make me laugh."*


Let's talk about this profile

First of all, this Vixen seems direct and clear about herself and her needs; she also is conversational and positive. She has talked about herself with out sounding too needy or egocentric. She was brief and positive about herself and others. She has a great photo, too (see next chapter about choosing photos).

We deliberately chose a profile that was simple and short to show you how easy and it can be to write a profile. Don't make your task too monumental or complicated. Leave something for your correspondence. The one thing men and women have in common is a dislike for wind bags who go on endlessly about themselves and their needs.

**"WHAT DO YOU MEAN, I
DOCTORED MY PHOTO?"**

A picture is worth a thousand words – so you better pick the right one!

Choosing the right photo to accompany your profile is equally important as the profile itself. We cannot overstate this. Men *are visually stimulated* (which is why they go to strip bars and women read). Although they might say “*it’s what’s inside that matters,*” men still line up to catch a glimpse of Angelina Jolie. What if you don’t look like Angelina Jolie? No worries. In the morning, neither does Angelina.

When you looked at *other* Cyber Vixens profiles (as we suggested earlier), you may have noticed that they sometimes say “photo available” instead of a photo. We do not suggest this. Sure, you might get some email, but most savvy Cyber Studs will want to see a photo first (before meeting), so be prepared.

How the hell do I scan my photo?

It’s easy. If you don’t have a scanner or a friend who has one, you can go to your local Kinko’s (or another local “copy place”). They will be happy to scan it for a minimal fee – usually five dollars or so.

What if the thought of posting my picture totally freaks me out?

If you are worried about your anonymity, sure you can always email photos directly to your “Digital Romeo” after corresponding by email (you big chicken). Keep in mind, however, your offers will greatly increase if you post your photos.

Don’t use the Best Photo you have ever taken of yourself

Make your photo an honest representation of you. Imagine how you will feel being misled by an inaccurate photo from a “Weaseling Web Worm.” Treat others as honestly as you would like to be treated. Fewer surprises mean less disappointment for everyone – and greater success.

Here are some guidelines on how to choose the appropriate photos that bring out the successful Cyber Vixen in you:

- Choose clear and recent photos of yourself. Don’t use photos that are several years (or several pounds) from your present state. You won’t be able to charm your way around an inaccurate photo. Don’t start off your first encounter with disappointment.
- Choose photos that show you in a good mood. Teeth are best – show ‘em if you got ‘em.

- Black and white photos tend to be more flattering and will also give you a classy feel – and we all want to be felt in a classy way.
- Make sure that at least one photo is large enough to see your face. There's nothing more annoying than a picture the size of a postage stamp (that no one wants to lick).
- Avoid *red-eye* photos that make you look like a crazed albino on crack.
- Avoid glary photos with the sun at your back – unless the sun rises and sets from your ass.
- Take a picture outside. Natural light is often flattering and makes you appear active...even if you are a couch potato with a glandular problem.
- Don't choose a picture with other people in it – especially if they are better looking than you.
- No porn – unless that's what you're looking for.
- Don't send a photo of someone else, claiming that it's you. Otherwise, sooner or later you will get “busted” (like we did, when we used pictures of the Baldwin Brothers). Trust us and learn from our mistakes.

Once you've uploaded your profile and photo, many of the services require that you wait a couple of days for them to be “approved.” Once approved, you will begin to receive overwhelming amounts of mail from “hyperlink hotties”. As we stated in the last chapter; you might want to open a special email account just for your online dating correspondence. Yes, the response is often that overwhelming...or “whelming.” If not, you may want to go back and rework your profile and pics.
